



Marine Engineer / Farms Mechanic

Wester Ross Fisheries currently have a vacancy for a Marine Engineer / Farms Mechanic to join our engineering team at our Ardmail Sea Site near Ullapool in the northwest of Scotland (although the role will involve travel to our other sites at Corry and Ardesie) – The role offered is permanent and full time, and will offer a level of autonomy in the running of our engineering workshop.

A background in either marine, agricultural or mechanical engineering would be desirable. Experience within the aquaculture industry would also be of benefit.

A full UK driving licence is essential – current valid certification in the following would also be preferred:

- A form of Marine Engineering qualification
- Telescopic and fixed mast forklift certification
- Accredited welding and fabrication certification
- Level 2 Powerboat qualification

A person with good practical and technical skills is required, as is the ability to work quickly and accurately under pressure and to manage and prioritise a varied workload. A person who is motivated, with good communication skills and who is able to work independently or as part of a team is expected.

Applicants should be physically fit - most of the work is outdoors and there is a requirement to persevere often under severe weather conditions.
