Main Objectives

To carry out the necessary routine duties involved in the production of salmon from smolt stage to marketable size.

To develop a good understanding of fish husbandry and to carry out allocated tasks to instruction and on time.

Main Duties and Responsibilities

To take part in all farm husbandry operations such as:

- 1. Feeding and movement of feed.
- 2. Stock appetite assessment.
- 3. Sampling, weighing and grading of stock.
- 4. Stock health monitoring including routine removal of mortalities.
- 5. Harvesting.
- 6. Site maintenance including lifting and changing of nets.
- 7. Boat handling.
- 8. Recording feed and chemical usage and fish mortality.
- 9. To participate in development trials as necessary.
- 10. To participate in 4 weekly weekend feeding rota.
- 11. To use all company property, plant and equipment safely and efficiently.

Health & Safety

All employees have a responsibility for ensuring that the way they carry out their work does not constitute a hazard to themselves or other members of staff.
